## Information for teenagers



If you have witnessed **WAR CRIMES** committed by the Russian armed forces **AGAINST CHILDREN**, testify to **juvenile prosecutors!**

In order to investigate war crimes and restore human rights and the rights of the child, representatives of our country need to document the relevant information.

**Information given by you can help bring war criminals to justice!**



### How to recognize a war crime?

**A war crime is a situation where you, your relatives or friends:**

- Lost a family member or has been injured from an occupier's weapon;
- Has experienced violence (psychological, physical, or sexual);
- Has been deprived of home due to damage from occupier's shells, or in the case of a home invasion;
- Has not been able to use the "green corridor" for a long time;
- Has been held by the occupants and deprived of freedom;
- Has not received food, medicine, basic necessities due to the blocking of humanitarian aid, etc.

**It's important for us to hear the voice of every child  
who has been exposed to military aggression!**
