You will be informed how and where you can testify to
the **juvenile prosecutor** about war crimes against children.

Confidentiality and precautions under the law are guaranteed!

If you have witnessed war crimes committed by the russian armed forces against children, testify to juvenile prosecutors!

In order to investigate war crimes and restore human rights and the rights of the child, you need to document the relevant information.

It will help to bring the perpetrators and the aggressor country to justice in national and international courts.



How to recognize a war crime?

A war crime is a situation where a child:

- Lost a family member or has been injured from an occupier's weapon;
- Has experienced violence (psychological, physical, or sexual);
- Has been deprived of access to medical care;
- Has been deprived of home due to damage from occupier's shells, or in the case of a home invasion;
- Has not been able to use the "green corridor" for a long time;
- Has been held by the occupants and deprived of freedom;
- Has not received food, medicine, basic necessities due to the blocking of humanitarian aid, etc.



In the case of a crime committed against a child, he or she will have the status of a victim with the right to compensate the harm caused.

We believe our joint efforts to be resultful and we will bring to justice everyone who stole the most precious thing – the smiles of our children!
